Key projects include a €120 million renewable fuels plant for HVO and SAF, a 100 MW solar park generating 100,000 MWh annually, and a €64.5 million green industrial area to attract wind technology manufacturers. 16:30-17:30	Company visit: Latvenergo Latvenergo is rapidly expanding its wind energy portfolio to enhance energy independence and sustainability. Through its joint venture Latvijas vēja parki, the company plans to develop 800 MW of onshore wind capacity by 2030. Additionally, Latvenergo acquired the 124 MW Telšiai wind farm in Lithuania, set to begin operations in early 2026. To accelerate renewable energy growth, the company has launched tenders for wind, solar, and hybrid power projects and is collaborating with Germany's RWE on offshore wind development in the Latvian Baltic Sea.
